

The Dalles Rifle & Pistol Club Regular Club Meeting Minutes

November 13, 2013

Called to order at 7:00 pm

Regular Club Meeting Minutes: None at this time due to absence of Secretary at September meeting.

Treasures Report: Ross Hucke made a motion to accept the Treasures Report with a second from Dave Peters and passed with a voice vote. Treasures Report is open for review by any club member in good standings.

Indoor Range Report: The Small Bore Season has started. Still looking for anyone interested to participate. Please contact with any of the Indoor Range Officers. Indoor Range hours are Monday & Wednesday from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm unless otherwise posted. The Last Monday of the month is set aside for Large Caliber Hand Guns. Ammunition will need to be tested by a Range Officer, has to be under 800fps and will not damage backstop. This WILL NOT BE up for discussion. Target funds have been turned in and Pistol Targets will need to be purchased before long.

Adult Handgun Class: January will be the next class followed by one in March. Classes last 2 to 3 weeks and are held on Tuesday and Thursday nights. Cost is \$50 per person.

Hunters Education: Next class starts January 17, 2014. Class will run for 6 weeks, Sign-up through ODFW website. Following class will be March/April. Space is limited so don't wait.

Friends of the NRA: Next year's banquet is fast approaching. Set your calendar now for February 15, 2014. We will again be holding our annual event at The Dalles Eagles. This year's event will be the best yet with even more goodies being offered.

Old Business: Klickitat Range is moving forward with the 1st hurdle passed. Noise Abatement is an issue with more info at the September meeting. 1st Goal for this property is a 100 yard line and pistol range. Following this will be a 300 yard line and possibly more. We will need more Range Officers so we can be open to the public per Klickitat County. Property Lease is estimated at \$1600 at 40 years.

Fire Extinguishers need to be serviced on the Indoor Range. Kathleen made a motion for \$300 to update current fire extinguishers and Zach W. seconded and passed by a voice vote.

Tim S. suggested that the club talk with a lawyer again about becoming a 501C3.

New Business: Tim Sipe gave an update on the possible new location of the Out Door Range. Currently a 40 year Lease is being proposed. Goal is for a 100 yard firing line by the fall of 2014. Please be patient as this is a LONG process.

Jack Bird has left firearms to Small Bore Team of The Dalles Rifle and Pistol Club. These rifles are Highly Modified and it has been proposed to Auction some of them off to 1st Current Club Members & 2nd any

other legal person. The goal is to help raise funds for the Small Bore Team to purchase needed equipment.

Kathleen Pimley is again putting together a Pistol Postal Match. This will start on December 15, 2013. Any interested persons need to contact Kathleen Pimley. Cost is \$20 and goal is for 6 person teams however 4 will work.

Due to the recent burglary at the Senior Center the keys have been changed. The Dalles Rifle & Pistol Club was not affected by the burglary but as a safe guard keys and codes have been changed. New keys have been issued.

January The Dalles Rifle & Pistol Club will be voting on Club Officers. The Current Officers are willing to continue their services for 2014. If there is anyone that would like to run for a position please make sure you are there on the January 8th, 2014 meeting.

Dues for 2014 will be \$65. Once we have an Outdoor Range current members will have 1st priority.
