## Minutes of Meeting January 10, 2018

Meeting called to order at 6:55 pm

Treasurers report: End of year report was read. Motion to approve was made and seconded. Motion approved.

Minutes of November meeting were read. Motion to approve was made and seconded. Motion approved.

Range report:

Range officers report that the ductwork modifications are complete. Electrical work also completed. Range is now available on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6pm to 8pm, for 22lr only.

Rifle team is using the range for practice on Mondays during the competition season. There are just enough members for the team to compete. Practice is Mondays at 5 pm.

Pistol shooter matches are Sunday from 1 to 3 pm, with practice on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6 to 8 pm. Dave Peters is calling the matches.

Old Business:

Hand gun class: Class leaders to discuss instructor lead classes as a group. Material has changed and there may be some concern over new material as print size is quite small. The material is not overly expensive at this time. When classes start we may need to order 75 sets, at estimated cost of \$1000.

Will try to have 4 classes per year, hopefully the first class will be early in spring, although it may not get advertised in the community college schedule.

There were no real obstacles seen to being able to hold classes.

Hunter ed. starts January 19. Sign up is on ODF website, there are still some openings for the January class. Next class will be in April.

Kevin McIntyre reported that sympathy cards had been sent to families of recently deceased members.

Matt Buckley and Kevin McIntyre have regained control of website. Minutes of November meeting have been posted. Updates will continue from now on.

New Business:

Motion was made and passed to extend 2018 membership to Mark and Linda Pellissier in exchange for Conex storage and for participation in running classes.

Motion was made and approved to waive 2018 membership dues for Secretary. Secretary asked his dues check be applied to land fund.

Tim Sipe raised issue of land for sale near Skyline Rd. Price is \$100,000. There is approximately 70 acres. This could be suitable for an outdoor range. Discussion followed about raising money as current membership level would not support this purchase.

Issue of Junior Membership was discussed. It is not an urgent concern as the parent of the junior shooter has joined NRA and club. Motion to form a committee to look into Junior memberships was made and seconded. Motion passed.

Motion was made and passed to keep current officers.

Motion was made and passed to make Dave Peters assistant indoor range officer.

Kathleen asked Tim Sipe for info on Range Officer Training. Tim said he will need to order materials.
