Old Business: Outdoor Range Report. We have been working with Klickitat County Range for a few years now. There is a deadline and our goal is to have a 100 yard range by June. This will be the first stage of the range and plans include Pistol Bays, and a 300 yard line. The county is looking at having us manage /run the range with 1.5 days open to the public. We will need to carry insurance and will need to have Club R.O.'s at all times. Hours of operations would be limited but unknown at this time. We are still in the planning stage with phase one almost finished. This does not mean we will stop looking for our own land but at least we will have some income and a safe place to shoot. Jim Wilcox made a motion for a 7 person committee to help with the draft of the RFP. We are still waiting to review the RFP and hopefully by the March meeting we will have more info.

Tim Sipe asked to look into the Club becoming a 501 C-3. This would not work without having a teaching piece.
